Please have the drill's and/or mud skid's serial number and use StraightLine part numbers when ordering. All customer orders will be invoiced through the respective StraightLine Dealer when applicable. Credit card orders are welcome.

Conditions of Sale -- Terms and Delivery

With approved credit, 30 day terms will be granted. A 2% discount is available for payments postmarked by the 10th day of invoice date. No discounts are allowed on freight.

Claims and Returns

In all cases, risk of loss and damage to goods in transit shall fall upon the purchaser. It is the purchasers' responsibility to file any loss or damage with the carrier. Inspect all shipments for damage upon receipt. If any damage is noticed with packaging or carton, do not sign for or accept it without the driver making a notation on the freight bill or receipt. After receiving the shipment, remove the goods and thoroughly inspect immediately. If any concealed damage is discovered, notify the delivering carrier immediately in writing. Do not move damaged merchandise until further inspection has been made. Save the carton and packing material for inspection. Do not attempt to return any goods to our factory without making prior arrangements with StraightLine Manufacturing, Inc. Claims shortages or inaccurate filling of orders must be made within 15 days after receipt of goods.

All returns must have a returned goods authorization number (RGA number) regardless of the reason for return. Please contact the StraightLine parts department for an RGA number. This number must appear on the outside of the box as well as on a tag attached to the individual part. There will be a restocking charge applied on any items returned for credit or exchange when the error is not ours. Goods must be in new and original condition.

Packaging

Returned goods must be properly and securely packed to avoid damage in shipment. Goods damaged in shipment due to poor or improper packaging will not be warranted. Proper storage and shipment of warranty parts is a customer responsibility. If any components are damaged by rain, mud, rust, poor packaging, etc., the purchaser will be charged for the part.

Inspection Charge

Goods returned for warranty consideration, inspection, and/or testing, and found to be in acceptable working condition, or if the cause of failure is determined not to be a valid warranty issue, will be subject to a minimum \$25.00 inspection and handling charge for each item.

Replacement Part Warranty

Warranty allowance on service parts is based on 90 days from the purchase date to the original purchaser. There is no warranty on ground engaging tools. Warranty credit will be based on invoice price.

Genuine StraightLine parts that are replaced under this warranty and installed by an authorized StraightLine Dealer, StraightLine Service Center, or StraightLine Service Representative will be repaired or replaced, with a new or remanufactured part as StraightLine elects, if a defect in materials or workmanship appears during the period of coverage. No allowance will be made for labor to remove or install the part during the 90 day warranty period.

STRAIGHTLINE WARRANTY INFORMATION SUMMARY

New Equipment Warranty

StraightLine Manufacturing, Inc. (Herein referred to as "StraightLine") warrants to the original owner each item of new equipment of its own manufacture against defective workmanship and material, under normal use and service, but not against damage of any kind resulting from misuse, neglect, abuse, improper use or maintenance. Units which have been used for demonstration purposes for less than 100 hours are "new" for this purpose.

Warranty Period

The warranty period to the original retail purchaser is twelve (12) months or 1,000 hours after date of delivery, whichever expires first. Ninety days on Service Parts (See the StraightLine Policies and Procedures Manual and the StraightLine New Equipment Warranty Policy for complete warranty information). This warranty is made to the original owner of new StraightLine equipment and is not transferable.

ALERT: StraightLine warranties are activated by receipt of the New Product Warranty Registration form which is sent with each new product. Registration forms on all new equipment must be completed and on file at StraightLine Manufacturing within fifteen (15) days of the date of delivery to the first purchaser. Failure to file will result in no warranty reimbursements.

Coverage

All parts which are defective in material or workmanship except component parts separately warranted by the original manufacturer will be repaired or replaced, at StraightLine's option. StraightLine will pay the cost of labor deemed reasonably necessary by StraightLine, to install any repaired or replaced part provided under this warranty, when labor is performed by authorized StraightLine personnel. The remedies set forth in this paragraph are exclusive and correction by StraightLine of product non-conformities in the manner provided above shall constitute fulfillment of all liabilities and obligations of StraightLine to those entitled to the benefit of this warranty. Warranty will not apply if failure is due to normal wear, exposure, accident, neglect, or improper protection, improper maintenance, improper winterizing and storage, or improper use.

Exclusions

This warranty shall not apply to general maintenance services or expendable replacement items. In addition, this warranty shall not apply to equipment not manufactured by StraightLine which is covered only by the warranty, if any, of its manufacturer. StraightLine reserves the right to discontinue models or options at any time or to change specifications, materials, or designs without notice and without incurring obligation.

Owner Responsibility

The owner is responsible for proper maintenance of the product. Any improper use, including failure to provide proper maintenance, operation after discovery of defective or worn parts, or operation beyond rated capacity shall void this warranty. This warranty shall not apply to any equipment which has been tampered with or altered after leaving our control, including but not limited to: foreign materials in the fluid system, pressure and speed in excess of published and recommended maximum, and damages resulting from repair by anyone except authorized StraightLine personnel. Charges for pick up, delivery, mileage, hauling, overtime, and service calls are not covered by this warranty.

Remedies Exclusive

The only remedies purchaser has in connection with the breach or performance of any warranty on StraightLine equipment are the remedies set forth above. StraightLine will not be responsible for any duty, taxes or other changes or liable for incidental or consequential damages, including, but not limited to, loss of profits, rental of substitute equipment, delay or other commercial loss. StraightLine's liability in all events is limited to the value of the product involved.

No Modification of Warranty

No StraightLine employee, representative or dealer is authorized to modify or change this warranty in any way or grant any other warranty unless the modification or change is made in writing and signed by an officer of StraightLine.

Drilling Fluid Circuit

All components of the drilling fluid circuit such as, but not limited to: The drilling fluid swivel, drilling fluid mixing/circulating pump, drilling fluid pressure pump, and related couplers, valves, seats, packings, seals, relief valves, bearings, shafts, housings, jets, etc., come in contact with an abrasive media when using Bentonite. These components are unquestionably wear items and are not covered under warranty.

Expendable Wear Items

Repair or replacement of expendable and normal wear items such as, but not limited to: Drill stem, ground engaging tools, bits, stakes, augers, saver subs, wrench jaws, cogs, and bodies, loose electrical wires, electrical umbilical cords and connectors, couplers, engine oil and filters, fuel filters, drill fluid strainers or filters, hydraulic oil and filters, drill fluid hoses and couplers, O-rings, roller chains and connector or repair links, sprockets, etc. will not be covered under this warranty. Warranty will not apply if failure is due to normal wear, exposure, accident, neglect, abuse, or improper protection, improper maintenance, improper winterization and storage, or improper use.

Limitations of Warranties and Applicable Law







Engine Frame Assembly





Hydraulic/Fuel Tank With Control Panel








